Dear Sir or Madam:

Colorado Discharge Permit System, Permit No. CO0048830 (the Permit) authorizes Gypsum Town of to discharge treated wastewater subject to the specific effluent limitations and other conditions of the Permit. 5 CCR 1002-61, §61.8, requires a permittee to comply with all of the terms and conditions of the permit.

The Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, Water Quality Control Division (division) has received your Discharge Monitoring Report (DMR) for the reporting period(s) as indicated in the attached report. However, the DMR(s), as submitted, is either missing the required monitoring data or the data was improperly reported (for example, the data may have been reported with the incorrect parameter code or incorrect units).

Failure to submit a properly completed DMR within the required timeframe constitutes a violation of the Permit.

To correct this violation, within fourteen (14) calendar days of the date of this letter, please submit a new DMR with the corrected data. The new DMR(s) should be clearly marked and highlighted as "Revised." Along with your revised DMR(s), please include a written explanation describing the cause of the improperly completed DMR and outline the actions and measures that have been taken or will be taken to ensure complete and accurate DMRs are submitted.

This Compliance Advisory is intended to advise you of alleged violations of the Colorado Water Quality Control Act, its implementing regulations and permits so that appropriate steps can be taken to avoid or mitigate formal enforcement action or to correct our records (if applicable). This Compliance Advisory does not constitute a Notice of Violation or Cease and Desist Order and is not subject to appeal. The issuance of this Compliance Advisory does not limit or preclude the division from pursuing its enforcement options concerning the above violation(s). The division will evaluate the facts associated with the above-described violation(s) and if a formal enforcement action is deemed necessary, you may be issued a Notice of Violation / Cease and Desist Order that may include the assessment of penalties.
