RE: Barr Lake RV Park

To Whom It May Concern:

1. There was a spill from our treatment pond of approximately 50 gallons of treated water.
2. This spill occurred on December 14, 2006 and was discovered by our on site maintenance engineer when he came to work at 7 am.
3. The spill was stopped that day and has not continued.
4. We have hired a pumping truck to pump out water to reduce the level in the pond and they are taking the water to the Lochbuie municipal treatment facility. The small amount of water has been absorbed in the ground and we have put gravel over the top of the effected area.
5. The cause of this spill was that the park residents suddenly increased their usage to help prevent their own units from freezing in the recent cold spell. In addition we had to remove several blockages in our sewer lines due to residents putting grease down their drains. To clean these lines we had the sewer lines power blasted with high pressure water. Both of these events created a greater amount of water to be put in the system and the rate of evaporation could not keep up.
6. None of the spill reached a surface water of the state.
