This letter is to inform you of the reasons for The DMR for January 2012 being late. First, my testing company, Test America, decided to stop sending me sample bottles. I do not know if it is their policy that I renew bottle orders every year, but since I have had trouble with them in the past, I have switched all monthly metals testing to Colorado Analytical. I pulled an effluent sample on the last day of January, and eventually got it sent off to Colorado Analytical on February 16. Due to some communication errors with a new testing company, they sent my test results to the Mt Crested Butte drinking water plant, who they also do testing for. I did not receive the reports until March 1. I then had some computer problems, as my software would not run the new DMR reporting spreadsheet provided by Kasey Kay. Admittedly, I should have checked that earlier, but since everything else I had gotten ran without problems, I assumed this would also. I have since upgraded my office computer to the new Microsoft Office standard, and can run the spreadsheet with no problems. I apologize for any inconvenience.
